

NORTH POOL

SOLARIUM AND SPRAY AREA

- Access is reserved for village guests during the posted opening hours.
- Entry outside opening hours or in the absence of authorized staff is prohibited. Lifeguard assistance is guaranteed in the cases and according to the procedures provided by current regulations.
- Maximum number of bathers allowed in the pool area: 200.
- Restrooms are located near the pools.

PROHIBITIONS

It is forbidden to:

- Bring animals into the area.
- Consume food and beverages in the pool area.
- Use glass items or dangerous objects.
- Smoke.
- Dive, run after one another, or engage in any other action that may cause danger or disturb other bathers.
- Leave objects or towels unattended on sunbeds and leave the pool area; staff will remove them.
- Occupy more than two sunbeds per umbrella.
- Allow access to children under 12 years of age unless accompanied.
- Enter the pool while in an altered psychophysical state (drunkenness, drug impairment, etc.) or in clearly poor health conditions that may endanger the person's own safety.
- Allow entry to persons with skin diseases, open wounds, or unsuitable hygienic conditions.
- In the pool, the use of specific educational aids for swimming lessons or training is permitted only under the supervision and responsibility of instructors. The use of inflatables, life rings, masks, fins, etc. is not allowed in the pool.

OBLIGATIONS

It is mandatory to:

- Take a shower and use the footbath before entering the water.
- Wear a swimming cap in the water.
- Follow the instructions of the staff.
- Leave the pools and pool area in case of rain or thunderstorms.

SPRAY AREA

- Access to the Spray Area is permitted only to children and teenagers aged 4 to 14 years. Children aged 4 to 12 years must be accompanied by a responsible adult.

- The Spray Area is not included within the area supervised by lifeguards.
- Running, pushing, diving, climbing on the structures, or engaging in dangerous behavior for oneself or others is prohibited.
- Consuming food, glass beverages, or bringing potentially dangerous objects into the area is prohibited.
- The flooring may be wet and slippery: users are required to pay maximum attention while using the area.
- Proper, respectful behavior in compliance with the rules of civil coexistence is mandatory.
- The area must be used in compliance with the hygienic conditions provided for by the facility regulations.
- Service staff may issue immediate instructions for reasons of safety, order, hygiene, or space management. Such instructions must be respected without exception.
- Management reserves the right to limit, regulate, suspend, or prohibit temporarily or permanently access to the area, even without prior notice, in case of:

- o overcrowding
- o technical or maintenance requirements
- o safety reasons
- o adverse weather conditions
- o improper use of the area
- o behavior not compliant with the regulations

Access to the area implies full acceptance of these regulations and of the general pool regulations.

Management is not responsible for behavior that does not comply with these regulations.
